




Everything you need to know before upgrading

What is it?

The term Maximo Application Suite mainly refers to a change in **licensing structure, application accessibility, and technology use**. Maximo's traditional functionality and user experience will remain the same.

1. **Licensing**: MAS is designed to take advantage of concurrent use and is therefore licensed via AppPoints, which are pooled and expended based on different active user types:



- 2. **Applications**: With MAS, all applications are available for installation within one suite. You can install everything at once initially or introduce new applications over time.
- 3. **Technology**: MAS utilizes Red Hat OpenShift, a containerization software that provides a secure, flexible foundation for IT infrastructure as your business needs grow and change.

MAS is sold **perpetually** or via **Subscription Term License (STL).** What about SaaS? You can take advantage of IBM's Managed Services offering or purchase through a third party

Who should upgrade?

- Clients adding users
- Clients wanting more functionality
- Clients wanting to improve management of users or move towards a concurrent model. (Points are easier to manage than named users in the system.)
